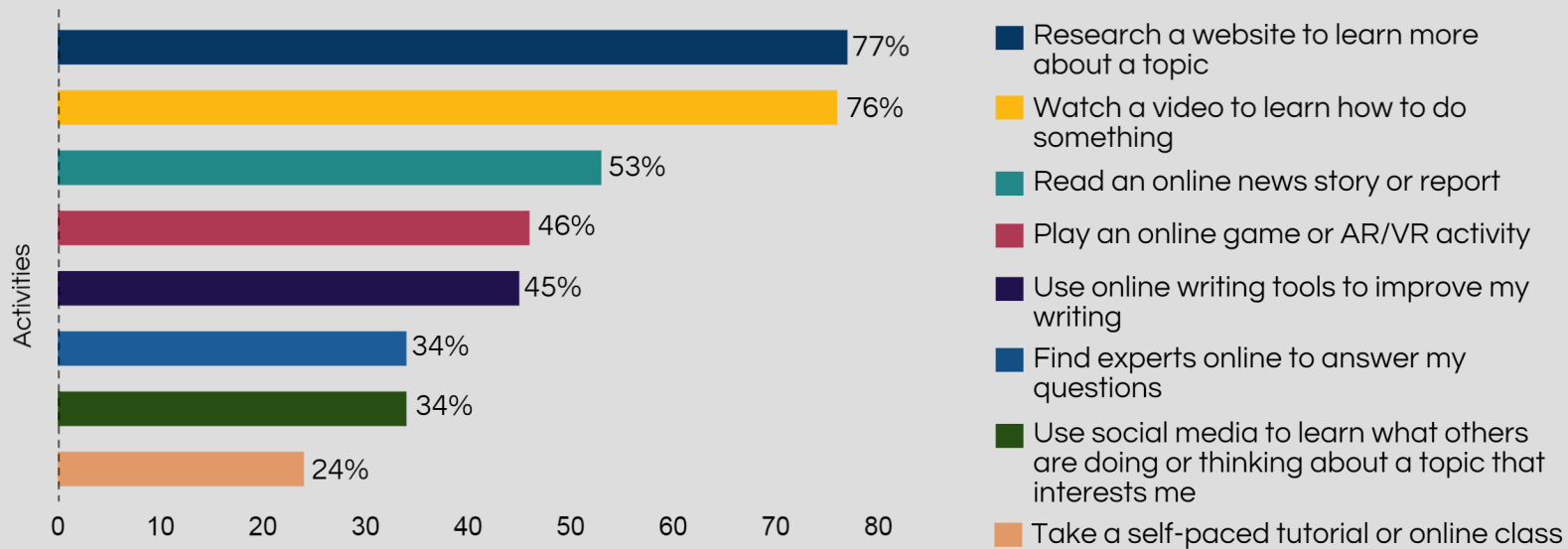


California Speaks Up! Results from Speak Up 2016

CA middle school students' experiences in school



84% say doing well in school is important



52% say the subjects they are learning at school will help them in the future



49% are interested in what they are learning at school

CA middle school students' experiences outside of school



70% like learning how to do things



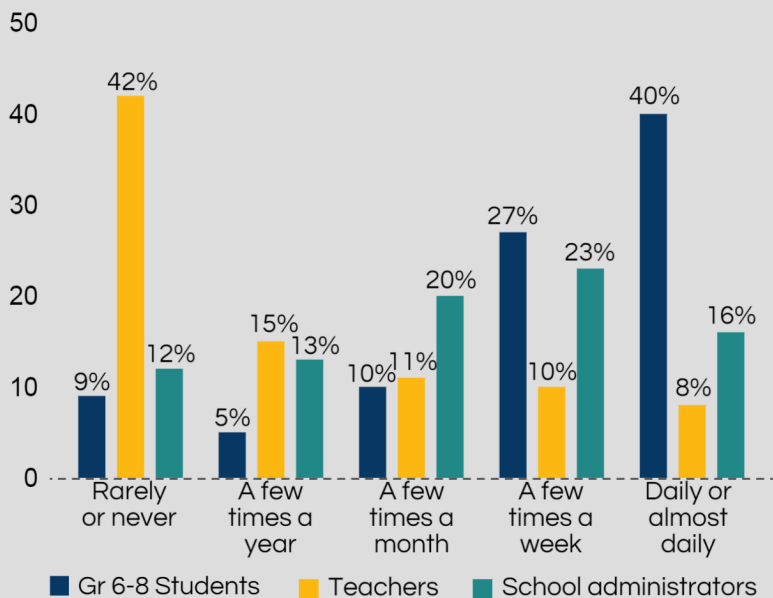
62% enjoy learning how to make or build things



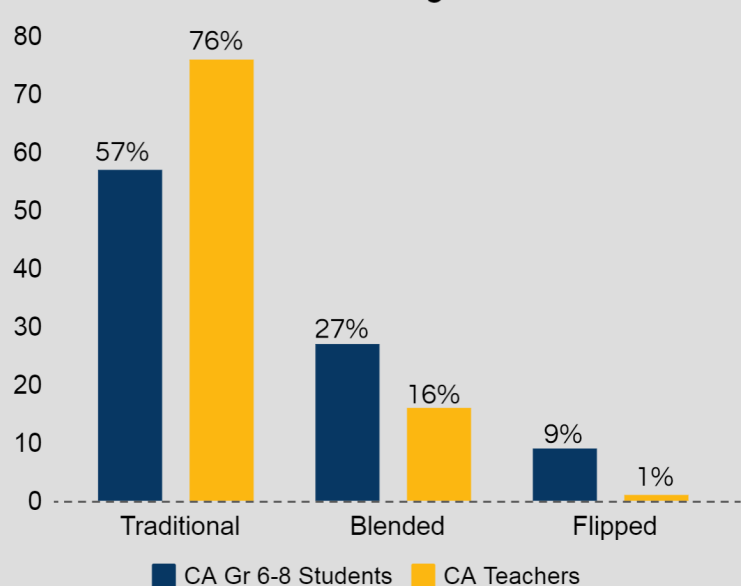
57% like learning about new ideas
