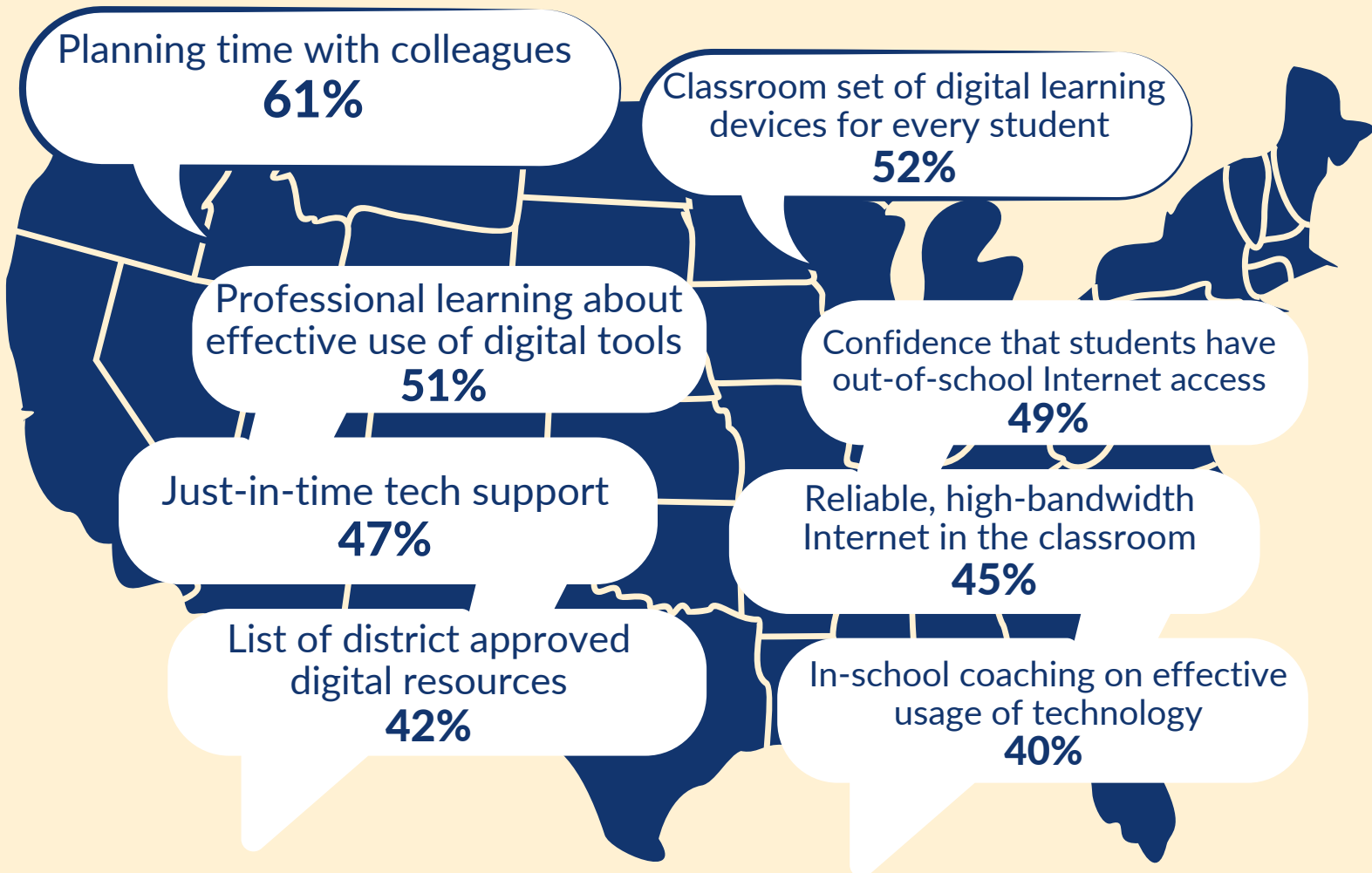


# WHAT K-12 TEACHERS SAY THEY NEED TO USE DIGITAL TOOLS MORE EFFECTIVELY

## TEACHERS WANT SPECIFIC PROFESSIONAL LEARNING TO ENHANCE THEIR INSTRUCTION TODAY

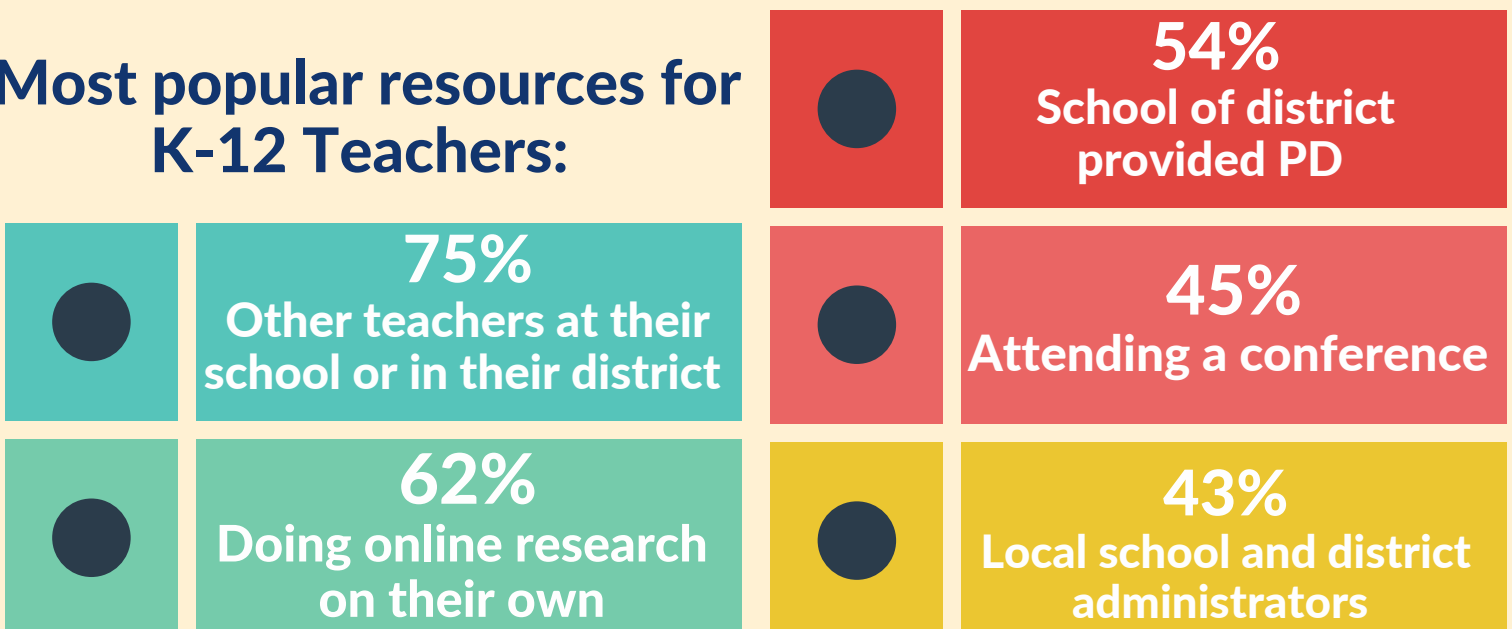

| Differentiate instruction using technology     | 56%               | 52%                     | 45%                      |
| Integrate digital content within lessons       | 41%               | 40%                     | 39%                      |
| Use digital or online games within instruction | 41%               | 40%                     | 33%                      |
| Use animations and simulations within lessons  | 36%               | 40%                     | 38%                      |
| Implement a social emotional learning program  | 30%               | 27%                     | 23%                      |
| Create my own videos for students to watch     | 28%               | 33%                     | 33%                      |
| Teach digital citizenship to students          | 27%               | 27%                     | 19%                      |
| Teach a fully online class                     | 13%               | 22%                     | 27%                      |
