Since 2003, the Speak Up data results have been used by education leaders and policymakers to inform strategic plans, community engagement, purchasing decisions, policy initiatives and funding for education. At Project Tomorrow we are most proud of the tremendous impact the Speak Up Project has had on stimulating and informing new visions for education from the halls of Congress to the local school board meeting.

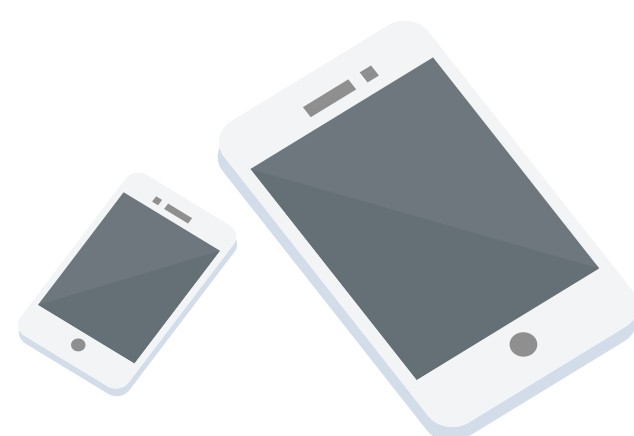

SURVEY TOPICS



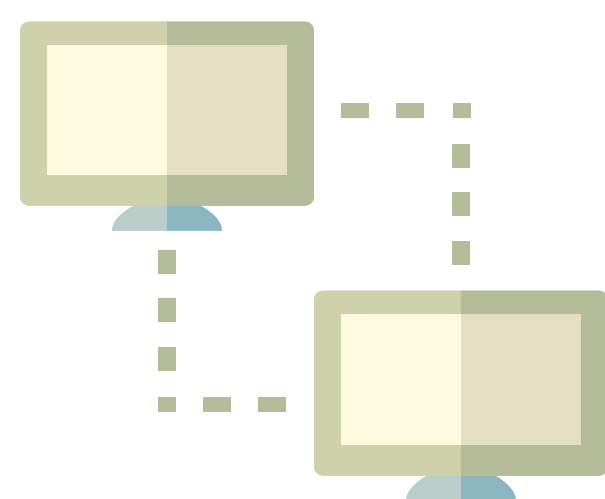
