## ABOUT THE SPEAK UP RESEARCH PROJECT

The Speak Up Research Project for Digital Learning is the research tool districts use to learn what students, educators, parents and the community have to say about education issues. A national initiative of Project Tomorrow, Speak Up is both a research project and a free service to schools and districts. Since 2003, Speak Up has helped education leaders include the voices of their stakeholders in annual and long-term planning. Education, business and policy leaders report that they use the data regularly to inform federal, state and local education programs.

### GET INVOLVED



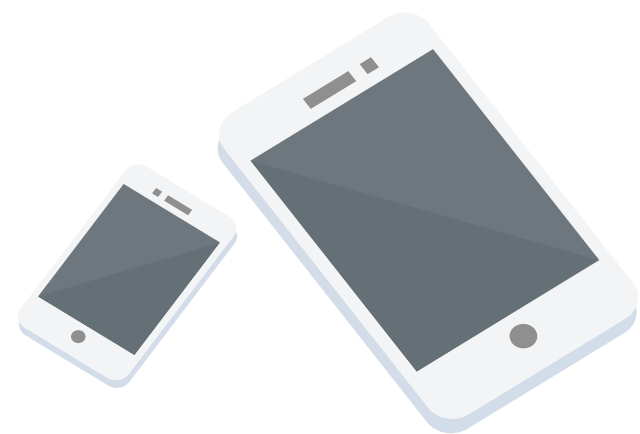


