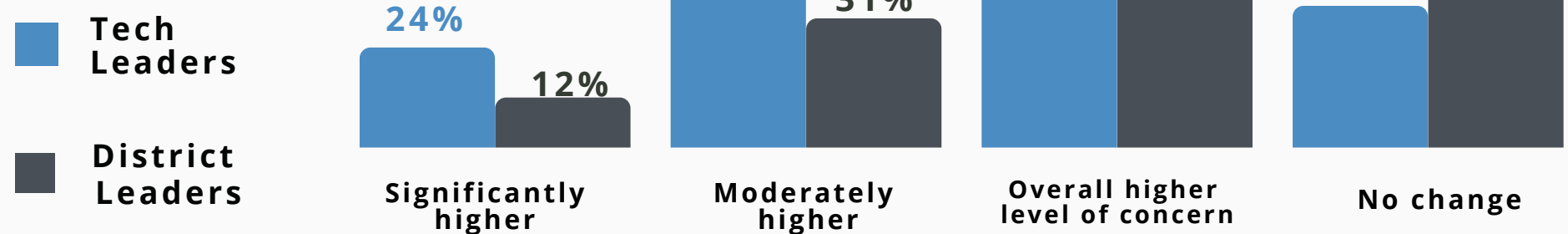

District Administrators and Technology Leaders have divergent levels of concern about cybersecurity.
